# Free up Cash in 30 Days **CUT DOWN DEBT & SAVE MONEY**

If you have a tight budget, the thought of finding any extra money can seem unrealistic. But with a few minor tweaks to your spending, it may be easier than you think. Here are ways to cut down on debt and actually save money in the long run:

### **CONSOLIDATE DEBT**

Sometimes the key to paying down debt can be as simple as combining it. One way to consolidate is to get a 0% balance-transfer credit card, transfer your debts to this card, and pay off the balance in full during the promotional period.

Another way is to get a variable-rate debt consolidation loan through your credit union. By consolidating your loans, you could save on interest rates, simplify monthly payments, and start saving money. However, if you're just going to use it to run up more debt, consolidation isn't right for you.

### **REFINANCE YOUR LOANS: HOUSE AND CAR**

Refinancing your loans to get a lower interest rate will free up money that can be put toward other bills or put into savings. A credit union loan representative can determine if you qualify for lower rates.

### **REVISIT YOUR POLICIES:** HOME AND AUTO INSURANCE

Check the National Association of Insurance Commissioners website and Insurance Information Institute for advice about picking reputable companies and then compare quotes from different companies.

Consider raising deductibles. Ask your insurer about good-student discounts for kids in high school and for college students who live away at school but leave their car at home.

### **GO GREEN**

Be environmentally conscious and save money while doing so. Programmable thermostats, fluorescent and LED bulbs, and window coverings are options that can help you save energy and money.

Go green at the credit union as well by signing up for eStatements and automatic bill payments. Using automatic bill pay will help you avoid late fees and make consistent progress toward your financial goals. Signing up for automatic loan payments may also get you a discount on your interest rate.

Ask a credit union loan representative for more information. With just a little research and a few emails or phone calls, you should be able to free up more cash to pay off debt or put into your savings account.

# **Donate Within Your Budget**GIVE SAFFLY & GUILT-FREE

The holidays are synonymous with giving. Not surprisingly, it's the time when most charities make their big push for a year-end boost to their bottom lines.

Unfortunately, there are fraudsters and phony charity organizations hoping to take advantage of potential givers. To protect yourself, ask a few simple questions and do a quick online lookup to determine if a charity is legitimate before you make your donation.

Ask about the charity's history, location, and tax ID number—if the answers seem fishy or vague, take a pass. If someone asks you for money in person, look up their organization on your cellphone before deciding to donate.

You know you won't be able to help every organization that asks for your donation. To help you give wisely and avoid feeling guilty for declining someone, create a giving plan.



- Decide how much you want to give either a dollar amount or percentage of income. Then choose an organization.
- Pick a charity that aligns with your beliefs and will spend your donation responsibly. The website givewell.org analyzes thousands of charities and provides information about their pros and cons.
- Decide how often you want to give and then stick to your plan. By

budgeting your generosity, you'll know at tax time exactly how much you've given and to whom.

• When asked for a donation by other organizations, simply explain you've already given another way.

It would be nice to be able to give to all your favorite charities, but not if it hurts your financial well-being. Give what is within your budget and do a little research before sending your donation.
