

Double Your Dollars Official Promotion Rules

No purchase necessary to enter or win the drawing. A purchase will not increase your chance of winning. Void where prohibited. Double Your Dollars, the "Promotion", begins at 12:01am CST on April 6, 2020 and ends at 11:59pm CST on June 7, 2020, the "Promotion Period".

Eligibility. The Promotion is open to members of Houston Police Credit Union and nonmembers who are 18 years of age or older; and who are U.S. citizens or U.S. resident aliens, or nonresident aliens subject to U.S. taxes. Employees, members and associate members of the board of directors, and volunteer officials of the credit union and its affiliates, and their immediate families (spouse, children, brothers, sisters, mother, father, grandparents, parent-in-laws, son-in-law, daughters-in-law, grandchildren, great grandchildren, and/or any legal dependents) and individuals living in the same household of each of the above are eligible.

Promotion. Deposit your check through mobile deposit using the HPCU mobile app during the Promotion Period for a chance to double your deposit up to \$500.00 with a minimum prize of \$100.00. One (1) random winner will be selected each week during the Promotion Period.

How to Enter. Deposit a check through mobile deposit using the HPCU mobile app during the Promotion Period. Members receive one (1) entry for each check deposited to their account through mobile deposit using the HPCU mobile app. If a member deposits multiple checks, each check deposited counts as one (1) entry. Checks drawn on another HPCU account owned or jointly owned by the same member who owns the account into which the deposit is made are not eligible. Check deposits that are fraudulent, tampered with or otherwise altered are not eligible. Each member is limited to winning one (1) prize during the Promotion Period.

To enter by mail without purchase or obligation, hand-print Double Your Dollars and your complete name, street address, city, state, zip code, and phone number on a 3" x 5" index card, and mail in a postmarked envelope it to: Houston Police Credit Union, ATTN: Marketing Department, 1600 Memorial Drive, Houston, TX 77007. Mailed entries must be postmarked between April 6, 2020 and June 7, 2020 and received by June 8, 2020 in order to be included in one of the random drawing listed below. Enter as often as you wish; however, each mailed entry will count as one (1) entry into the random drawing and must be mailed in a separate, postmarked envelope. Entries that are mechanically reproduced, copied, illegible, incomplete or inaccurate and entries that subvert the entry process by any means are void. A \$100.00 cash prize will be substituted for a winning member or nonmember without a qualifying mobile deposit using the HPCU mobile app during the Promotion Period. Entries become the property of HPCU and will not be acknowledged or returned. Incomplete entries or entries not complying with these official promotion rules are subject to disqualification at HPCU's sole discretion. Proof of mailing does not constitute proof of delivery or receipt.

Prizes. One (1) winner will be selected each week during the Promotion Period. HPCU will award the winner with funds equal to the value of the selected winning mobile deposit up to \$500.00. If the value of the winning mobile deposit is under \$100.00, the winner will receive \$100.00. If the value of the winning mobile deposit is over \$500.00, the winner will receive \$500.00. The funds will be deposited into the same HPCU account of the selected winning mobile deposit. Winners will be selected on Tuesdays for mobile deposits the previous week, Monday - Sunday. If Tuesday is a federal holiday, the winner will be selected on the following business day.

Odds

The odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received during the Promotion Period.

HPCU reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who is found to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Promotion, to be acting in violation of these official promotion rules, or who otherwise takes actions that do or are intended to disrupt or undermine the legitimate operation of the Promotion.

Governing Law. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these official promotion rules shall be governed and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the state of Texas without regard to the choice of law provisions thereof.
